Other position duties include:

- Performing on-site physical inspections and loss control surveys for clients and prospective clients.
- Analyzing loss control data and needs for clients and developing and implementing strategies to define problems, collect data, establish facts and draw valid conclusions.
- Developing and reviewing written programs and recommendations for safety initiatives including corporate safety, crisis management, workplace violence, fleet program, hazard communications, drug and alcohol programs and policies, and more.
- Providing technical assistance and guidance to clients and our agency by coordinating loss control activities with insurance company and carriers loss control personnel.
- Conducting educational seminars (including safety instruction), researching and publishing safety newsletters, and monitoring loss information and historical data.
- Facilitates training including OSHA 10 and 30 hour, personal protective equipment, driver and fleet safety, etc.

This position requires:

- The ability to conduct meetings and consultations in active commercial construction sites with exposure to outside weather conditions up to 30% of the time.
- Excellent customer service, presentation, interpersonal and verbal and written communication skills, telephone etiquette, and follow up and follow through.
- Ability to work independently, prioritize and manage workload, and identify and act upon urgent tasks.
- Experience working with various office equipment and systems including computer, copy machines, scanners, etc.
